Also on the program is Bizet’s “L’Arlesienne Suite No. 2,” Anderson’s “First Day of Spring,” and Young Artist Youth Division Winner Channa Lee will be performing Vitali’s *Chaconne* for violin, and Youth Division Winner Kai Freeman, performing the first movement of Mendelssohn’s *Violin Concerto*.

According to Music Director Joseph Lovecchio, “An Overture to Spring” is brimming with the spirit and vitality of the new season. Its’ varied styles and our two gifted young soloists will bring joy and inspiration to everyone.”
